

Minutes of the Public Works Advisory Committee  
03/19/2012 at the Tracy Memorial

Edgar Acevedo brought the meeting to order at 7:02 PM.

Committee Members Present: Jim Simmons (co-chair), Marty Schmitt, and Steve Campbell.

Also in attendance: John Bartholomew (DPW employee).

The minutes of 03/05/2012 were approved with a motion to approve by Edgar Acevedo which was seconded by Marty Schmitt.

The proposed agenda was approved , Steve Campbell making the motion to approve which was seconded by Marty Schmitt.

Jim Simmons reported that he had not yet received a reply from Senator Saland regarding grants or funds that may be available for the village to utilize for DPW projects.

John Bartholomew advised the committee on the state of the water system infrastructure noting that the areas most in need of attention were: Spring Street (relining of sewer pipes because of collapsed and severely deteriorated sections), Woodbridge Ave. from railroad tracks to Rte 203, Moore Ave. to 1<sup>st</sup> street on Houseman Ave., and Harmon Heights. He said that the leaks in the water tower were on seams and in the metal plates.

It was agreed that the Public Works Advisory Committee Report dated 3/19/2012 should be amended to state that these 3 topics were the first of more to come so that the Mayor and Trustees did not think that this was our final report.

Because many if not all of our recommendations involve the village DPW staff, we determined that we would try to study the issues relating to the workforce and their participation in addressing the problems that have been identified.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:39 PM with a motion to adjourn by Edgar Acevedo seconded by Marty Schmitt.
