Leaf Pick-Up: This years' leaf pick-up will start on October 3rd and run until weather permits. Please remember; *leaves only*! Brush, stones, and other waste will damage our machine and cannot be accepted.

Bundled sticks will be picked up for the month of October *only*. The DPW will collect them separate from the leaves. Branches should be tied in bundles.

Wood should be cut as follows:

over 2" in diameter – 2 feet long / under 2" in diameter – 4 feet long.

No bagged leaves will be picked up. Downed limbs, brush, yard clippings, and bagged leaves may be disposed of at the DPW garage on Brookside Avenue between the hours of 7:00 am and 3:30 pm, Monday through Friday. Land clearing or tree removal cannot be brought to the DPW garage but can be taken to the Greenport Transfer Station.
