<u>"KISS" SHREDDING PROGRAM</u>: The "Keeping Identities of Seniors Safe" program, sponsored by the Columbia County Clerk's Office, is once again available for seniors at the Tracy Memorial Village Hall. March 11, 2024 – March 22, 2024, 8am – 4pm.

TRASH AND RECYCLING: County Waste begins trash and recycling collection each Wednesday morning at **7:00 a.m**. Please have all of your recycling and garbage placed at your curbside before that time (drivers will not return to collect items that are not out by 7:00 am). Due to changes in driver scheduling, weather, etc., the pick-up time at your residence may vary from week to week.

VILLAGE ELECTIONS: The Village of Chatham, Columbia County, New York, has two (2) elected offices to be filled at the Village Election on Tuesday, **March 19, 2024**, as follows:

Office of Trustee, Village of Chatham, two (2) year term, ending April 1, 2026 **Office of Trustee**, Village of Chatham, two (2) year term, ending April 1, 2026

This election is administered by the Columbia County Board of Elections. Petitions and other papers required for candidacies for these offices at such election must be filed with the Columbia County Board of Elections, 401 State Street, Hudson, NY in accordance with the applicable specifications and time periods of the New York State Election Law.

LEAF AND YARD DEBRIS COLLECTION: Leaf and yard debris collection will begin in April. The Village requests your use of biodegradable bags for leaves. Please do not put twigs or sticks in the bags.

Properly sized, bundled sticks and branches will be collected at a later time if they are placed at the curb next to the biodegradable bags. Branches should be tied in bundles, and should be cut as follows: over 2'' inch diameter – 2 feet long / under 2'' in diameter – 4 feet long.

HEAVY TRASH DROP OFF: May 20-23, 2024. The Village will once again offer heavy trash "drop off" at the DPW Garage. The Village Resident Drop-Off Voucher can be obtained at the Clerk's Office. Only Village residents are eligible and will be required to show proof of residency. Limit 1 voucher per household. Items <u>NOT</u> permitted: Hazardous waste, Animal carcasses, Firearms, Ammunition, fireworks, Asbestos, tires, appliances with Freon (A/C's or fridges), TV's, Computers, Office Equipment.

WATER/SEWER: If you would like to register for paperless billing, please email your request to the Deputy Clerk at <u>sdavis@villageofchatham.com</u>. Be sure to provide the email address to which you would prefer to have e-bills sent.

VILLAGE E-MAIL NOTICES: Please consider subscribing to the Village email to receive important announcements such as office closings, changes in trash pickup, water main breaks, snow emergencies that require parking restrictions, and more. GARDEN HOSE METERS: Garden hose meters measure the water used from your outdoor spigot. Depending on your outdoor usage, you may find it advantageous to purchase an outdoor garden hose meter and periodically bring the meter to the Clerk's office in order to receive a credit on the sewer portion of your water/sewer bill. If you would like more information please contact our office. (Garden hose meters are available at many hardware stores and online in a wide range of prices).
