**INVITATION TO BID**

A sealed bid for the:

**VILLAGE OF CHATHAM  
WATER STORAGE TANK CONSTRUCTION**

The project generally consists of the following work:

Contract 1 – General Construction - Preparing the Site for the Work; grading and stabilizing slopes; furnishing and installing 428,000-gallon glass fused to steel water storage tank; furnishing and installing 250-linear feet of 10” PVC water main with connection to existing Village water system; furnishing and installing any and all appurtenances associated with a water storage tank, including, but not limited to, access drive, fence with gate, fire hydrant, catch basin and piping for tank overflow; coordination with property owners for water service disruption; coordination with utility companies; maintenance and protection of traffic, and record drawings.

Contract 2 – Electrical - Preparing the Site for the Work; select electrical demolition; furnishing and installing 200 linear feet of underground electrical duct banks; furnishing and installing hand-holes; furnishing and installing panelboard; furnishing and installing branch circuits; instrumentation and control circuiting; furnishing and installing light fixture, base, pole, and controls; furnishing and installing electrical boxes, fittings, and enclosures; grounding; controls and integration; furnishing and installing electrical backboard and support hardware; furnishing and installing cellular antenna, and record drawings.

This work will be awarded as two (2) contracts.

Work for Contracts 1 and 2 shall be substantially completed and operational by August 24, 2018 and ready for final payment by September 19, 2018.

The Bids will be received on a lump sum basis with alternates, if included, for Contract 1 and Contract 2.

The Bids should not include sales and compensating use taxes on materials incorporated into the work.

Bids actually received by mail or by hand after the appointed time on the date specified shall be rejected, notwithstanding that such Bid may have been placed in a mail box or other mail receptacle regularly maintained by the United States Postal Service before such time, and ordinarily in sufficient time to have

been delivered on time.

Bid security in the amount of 5% of the Bid must accompany each Bid in accordance with the Instruction to Bidders.

The successful Bidder will be required to furnish a performance bond and a payment bond, each in an amount equal to 100% of the contract price.

The Contractor shall also comply with the New York State Environmental Facilities Corporation Minority and Women’s Business Enterprises Equal Opportunity Program, further described in the Contract Documents. The utilization of American Iron and Steel (AIS) is also a requirement of the Contractor, further described in the Contract Documents.

Attention of Bidders is particularly called to the requirements for ensuring that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of their race, color, religion, sex or national origin.

The Village of Chatham, as Owner, reserves the right to waive any informalities or irregularities in the Bid received, or to reject any or all Bids without explanation.
